





- Bookang has very little time to explain concepts and to resolve doubts. We are too many in class and thus can't really help.
- BookKang is SO intelligent that sometimes he focuses on the technical jargon a bit more than what's done in lecture. My only suggested would be to coordinate the lectures and seminars more with Professor Weinhold.
- But sometimes it wastes time socializing and distracts us from work.
- He goes very fast over the equations. He assumes that we know how equations work. I've had a very hard time with this.
- He is good. Keep it up! Thank you for making us understand the materials during seminars. 1.5 hours of seminar would be great, instead of 1 hour. Thanks, Boo Kang!
- he is not a strong communicator/struggles to explain concepts in a clear manner. he also seems unsure of his own answers half the time, which makes students insecure as well.

- I think sometimes Bookang underestimates how little students know about statistics/econometrics. Although overall he's very helpful, he sometimes tries to explain things through equations or concepts which people don't always understand. 
